Admissions Timeline for Prospective Students and Families
2018-2019 School Year (for Fall 2019 Admission)

November

8th Grade Showcase Days - November 2 and November 16

8th Grade classes from all in-district Middle Schools visit Keefe Tech for a Showcase Day. Students select two Career and Technical Programs to explore and Keefe Tech assigns them a third. Students spend about a half hour in each Program.

Career Night Open House - Wednesday, December 5 from 5:30PM - 8PM

Prospective student and their families are invited to attend our Career Night highlighting the Keefe Tech high school experience.

December

Apply to Keefe Tech! Options for applying to Keefe Tech:

1. **Fill out our online application - keefetech.go2cte.com** - your Middle School Counselor will be notified that you applied and include the necessary records with it.

January

Continue to apply Keefe Tech - Priority Application Deadline - January 15, 2019

8th grade interviews begin. All interviews are conducted at in-district Middle Schools. Out-of-district students or students enrolled at private schools will be contacted by our Admissions Department to set up an interview on the Keefe Tech campus.

February

8th grade interviews continue. First round of interviews is completed before February vacation.

Welcome Orientation Dinner - Thursday, May 2, 2019 - Accepted students and their parents/guardians are invited to attend a dinner with their future classmates. Families will be asked to select a Career and Technical Program they would like to spend more time in that evening.

June

Accepted Students Day & Parent Information Session - Thursday, June 6, 2019

Keefe Tech invites all accepted students to a program after school that includes signing up for activities and athletics, connecting with future classmates and selecting their 8 Career and Technical Programs for exploratory. Keefe Tech provides transportation from each middle school at their specific dismissal time and a parent/guardian pick-up is required at 5PM. There will be a **Parent Information Session held on the same day from 4:30-5:00 PM** for interested families, in the East Side Room Restaurant prior to student pick-up.

August

Freshmen Orientation - Date TBD (usually the Thursday before the first day of school)
